
## \* Printing Instructions \*

## Find Size Using A Ring




Take the ring you know fits the intended finger and place it over the rings below to find the size that matches the inside edge of your ring, if it falls between two sizes, it is recommended to go for the larger size.



## **Paper Ring Sizer**

For trying to find your ring size at home, we have created a paper ring sizer, simply print this page, cut out the sizer below, cut the slit and then place around the base of your finger to find your size but make sure it slides over your knuckle.



We can't guarantee the accurracy of the paper sizer due to potential print variations and that paper doesn't hold its shape very well, which is why we recommend going to a jeweler or using a proper ring sizer.
